

The FACE Orthodontic Philosophy, Treatment Goals and Methodology

The Evolution Appliance: the latest solution for old challenges.

Update on Treatment Mechanics. Part I.

Since the introduction of the Straight Wire Appliance in 1970 by Lawrence F. Andrews, other prescriptions have emerged in which some values of torque, angulation and rotation are changed but basically preserving almost all values of the original Andrews setup. In most cases, these modifications seek to solve certain aspects of orthodontic biomechanics, without missing those in which no clear justification is not appreciated. At present, orthodontics also shows that the concept of variable prescription has been imposed to a single one, in order to treat the entire universe of orthodontic anomalies. Technological advances impose on us new challenges; among them the Cone Beam Computed Tomography (CBCT), which gives us the vision of a reality we can not ignore and that will certainly change many of the concepts of traditional orthodontics. Studies with this mean of diagnosis, show that a significant percentage of individuals have dehiscence and fenestrations before orthodontic treatment suggesting modifications of the existing prescriptions and treatment modalities. The new prescription, FACE Evolution, is designed to solve these and many other aspects, that with any doubt are going to change a lot of the concepts of traditional Orthodontics. Orthodontics is evolving from an Occlusion driven Paradigm to a Face driven model where the malocclusion is considered in the contest of the Face.

Function and Esthetics are equally important.

The Face becomes the cornerstone of our treatments in which Interdisciplinary Know how guides our choices. Digital planning helps the Orthodontist and the Components of the Interdisciplinary Team to define Protocols of Treatment with precise 3D objectives and sequences of interventions, making it easier to decide who does What and When. FACE, Interdisciplinary Know How and Digital Planning are Keywords of the Future of Dentistry.

The Importance of vertical control for function, esthetics and stability from childhood to adulthood.

Class II's can be of a anterior/posterior nature, however many class II's are vertical and therefore manifest posterior rotation of the mandible. In many instances we have a good mandibular body and if we are able to control the vertical growth of the teeth and the alveolar process we will be able to produce anterior rotation of the mandible and therefore correct the class II, the overjet and the open bite. In my presentation I will cover the concept of vertical control in children, adolescents and adults with different techniques.

Extractions for Function, Esthetics and Stability.

Orthodontics for the last hundred years has debated whether we need to extract or not extract...the famous extraction non extraction debate. In my presentation I will give solid information and arguments of why you need to extract in many cases. When done correctly with extractions you will improve facial esthetics and not the opposite, you will achieve a correct functional occlusion which in turn will improve the possibility of protecting the TMJ's and obtaining stability and last but not least for good periodontal support. In my presentation I will show many cases of well treated extraction cases.
