THE IMPORTANCE OF THE VERTICAL DIMENSION, CONDYLE POSITION AND THE USE OF SKELETAL ANCHORAGE



Dr. Domingo Martín received his BA from the University of Southern California and his MD and DDS from the University of Bilbao, Spain. He later obtained his Masters in Orthodontics from the University of Valencia, also located in Spain.

Dr. Martín attended the Roth Williams Center from 1991 to 1993, obtaining a diploma in functional occlusion and is its current director for Spain and Portugal as well as the president of the Roth Williams International Society of Orthodontics. He is an active member of the European Angle Society and a Diplomate of European Society of Orthodontics.

In addition to being a visiting professor at the International University of Catalunya – Barcelona and the University Complutense of Madrid, Dr. Martín has presented courses and conferences throughout Europe, Russia, Asia, Australia and North America. His practice limited to orthodontics is located in San Sebastian, Spain.

After completing his Masters Degree he expanded his experience in orthodontics and Orthognathic Surgery in the United States with Larry Andrews, Ronald Roth and Bill Arnett. He has been clinical professor at the Department of Orthodontics, University of Milan from 1993 to 2008.

He is a member of the EOS, AAO, SIDO and active member of the Angle Society of Europe. He has a private practice in Parma, Italy where he directs the FACE Ortho Surgical Center in cooperation with the chief surgeon Professor Mirco Raffaini.
