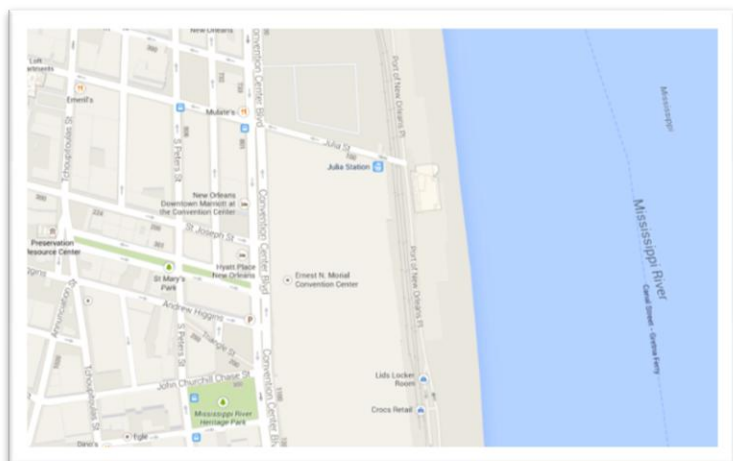

- Registrations received between April 1<sup>st</sup> and April 21<sup>st</sup> qualify for the Advance Registration rate.
- After April 21<sup>st</sup> registrations are considered Onsite Registrations. Please do not send any forms to the RWISO office after April 21<sup>st</sup>.

## Payment Option

Attendees have the option to pay their conference registration in two equal payments.
