He has lectured widely throughout the world. Dr Martin also has a private practice in San Sebastian, Spain.

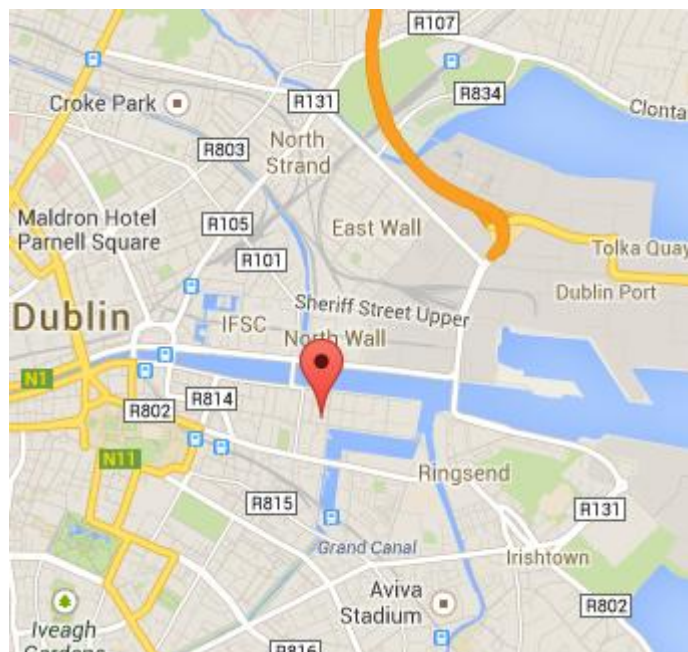
